1. **CALL TO ORDER:** Goralnik called the meeting to order at: 1:00 p.m.

2. **ADOPT A RESOLUTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH AB361:**

The members voted unanimously to adopt a resolution in accordance AB361

3. **APPROVE MINUTES FROM 5/21/2021:**

The minutes from 5/21 were approved.

4. **WELCOME ABBY MILLER:**

The members welcomed Abby Miller, the CPSAC's newest member.

5. **DISCUSSION OF IMPLEMENTATION OF CREATIVE PLACEMAKING STRATEGY POL. 1:**

Goralnik shared that an informal subcommittee of members has been working on developing a strategy for implementing this policy which is a recommendation in the Creative Placemaking Strategy. The subcommittee members were not available to provide an update on their work thus far, but Goralnik provided an overview of how the subcommittee would present out to the larger committee and how the recommendations of the subcommittee and, ultimately, the larger committee, would be applied.

The members introduced themselves to Abby and shared perspectives on their views of public art.

6. **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Goralnik provided an update on other initiatives that are implementation measures of the adopted Creative Placemaking Strategy. These include an upcoming application to the Clean California grant program to install several murals in downtown Mariposa in conjunction with the Mariposa Creek Parkway. Jeanetta requested that a list of the potential mural locations be shared with the Historic Sites and Records Preservation Committee, and Goralnik committed to doing so as soon as possible. She also suggested including a letter of support or similar from the Historic Sites group in the grant application if possible.

Additionally, Goralnik reminded the group about the Mariposa Creek Parkway Phase IV Special Plan project, which is anticipated to align with a Creek Week-type event to support the planning effort. He informed the committee that this event would take place at the end of May or beginning of June in 2022, and that the committee would likely play a large role in implementing that effort.

7. **ADJOURN:** Goralnik adjourned the meeting at 1:50 PM.
