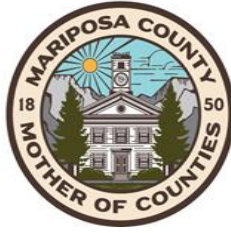

1. SSTAC Meeting called to order by Jeannie Morvay-Clayton at 10:03 AM.
2. Introductions and a Determination of a Quorum.
3. SSTAC currently has four vacancies.
4. Notice of Meeting and Notice of Vacancies advertised in the local newspaper, letters mailed out to SSTAC interested parties mailing list, notices published on county websites, and posted at county buildings.
5. Tina Gavette moved to accept the minutes from October 26, 2022, meeting, Debra Barcellos seconded the motion with all members in concurrence.
6. Debra Barcellos moved to accept the Annual Report for 2022, Tina Gavette seconded the motion with all members in concurrence.
7. Debra Barcellos, from Mariposa Heritage House, shared a Presentation with us on their fixed route transit program. (Presentation attached.) Debra let the group know that their LICN Grant, funding the transit program, would be ending in 2024. They are currently seeking funding sources to continue the transit program after 2024.

8. Jordan Van Delden gave us an update from Mariposa Transit. In FY 21/22 they had 7,800 1-way trips with nine drivers and two office staff. As of March 2023, Mariposa Transit was operating at 100% occupancy, has ten drivers, and four office staff.

Mariposa Transit is once again offering weekly shopping trips to Atwater and is adding weekly trips to the Mariposa Farmers Market, which will be available May through the end of October. Publication of the Mariposa Transit Offerings will include these new additions.

They are still researching scheduling programs which will allow Transit to make the switch to virtual vouchers.

9. There was a question about working with YARTS to provide a midday pick-up and drop off in the El Portal area. This would help residents looking to connect with Mariposa Transit for various appointments. Jeannie will reach out to our YARTS contact to research this possibility.

10. SSTAC Meeting adjourned at 10:55 AM. Next meeting will be October 2023 date/time TBD.
