4. County Items

- Foresta Bridges - MGE / Public Works Meeting
 - Meeting requested by EP PAC with MGE and Public Works did not happen in March.
 - Committee reiterated the standing request for an update on this Public Works contract (initial request for community update made in 2020)
 - **ACTION ITEM:**
 - Supervisor Smallcombe will identify meeting date with Public Works and MGE and committee will advertise recruit attendees

- Parkline - No overnight Camping Ordinance Timeline / Enforcement
 - See attachment for social media example
 - Timeline to ordinance taking effect:
 - April 6 first reading
 - April 20 second reading
 - May 20 ordinance goes into effect
 - Includes schedule of fines
 - \$350 level set by CA vehicle code
 - \$72 and \$100 discussed by Board of Supervisors
 - Committee feedback on fine?
 - Committee endorses a fine of \$100 for violation of ordinance
 - Concern exists for pullouts not covered by this ordinance that are under USFS jurisdiction.
 - Will require collaboration with USFS staff

 - **ACTION ITEM:**
 - Committee will help notify public about impending change
 - Post temporary sign on Yosemite View Lodge fence
 - Supervisor Smallcombe to follow up with USFS contacts for other pullouts that will need to be addressed
- PG&E Project – Exchequer – Yosemite Reliability Project
 - 2019 & 2020 phases are complete downstream
 - PG&E owns line up to Yosemite View Lodge
 - PG&E contracted to replace NPS owned line within park boundaries
 - Summer 2021 Phase III – (Briceburg to Yosemite)
 - Work will take place 6 days / week, 7 am – 5:30 pm
 - Helicopters will be used throughout to move workers and materials
 - Outreach letters will be sent, door to door customer contacts will occur
 - 20 miles of line, 54 tower replacements, 1 tower modifications
 - All towers will have safety enhanced
 - Replacement & re-tensioning of 70K line
 - Avian protection measures, structural upgrade
 - Rough Schedule:
 - Vegetation Work – May, June, July
 - Civil Foundation – Fall / September
 - Completion – November
 - Square lattice steel towers (4' wide)
 - See attachment for example replacement pole
 - Micropile foundations
 - 4-6 holes drilled in ground
 - Air compressors, concrete
 - Setting Tower
 - Arrive prebuilt – installed with crane or helicopter
 - Helicopters
 - Need to identify landing zones
 - Stage materials in Mariposa
 - Drive up to LZ and deploy same day
 - Rancheria
 - Access road to site above town for pulling line

- Highway 140 lane closures to mitigate debris fall
 - Caltrans Inspector (Bob Gill) Point of Contact
 - message boards
- Customer Power will stay on via generators
 - Power interruptions will be related switching
- **ACTION ITEM**
 - Nathan to provide map of work locations, veg removal, PPT
 - Alan to confirm NPS Compliance timeline
- Ferguson Permanent Restoration Project Update
 - See April PDF presentation for details and renderings

 - Click on the file link under Resources titled-Ferguson Rock Shed Project Update April 2021
 - Current Phase – Talus Removal 2021
 - Off haul will take place in mid-May to winter
 - Single trucks at a time, will utilize pull-outs
 - Approximately \$27M budget for current phase
 - This project is a collaborative design with contractor and PG&E
 - Typically, Caltrans designs in-house, then bid and build
 - First time segmented construction jacked through a curve
 - PG&E describes this as a signature project for District 10
 - Next cost estimate due in May
 - 2019 estimate was \$117M
 - Caltrans will then seek to secure constructions funds in Winter 2021
 - Rock Shed construction to start late summer 2022
 - Concrete piles, forming and casting retaining base
 - Then cast and form segments and jack into place 11 segments
 - 5 years of construction anticipated
 - Post-construction – will remove bridges, abutments, slope
 - Portable concrete batch plant at CalTrans Sandpile Area in 2021
 - Will install project cameras for updates
 - Will post to Facebook & Twitter
