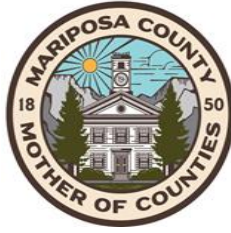

## Social Services Transportation Advisory Council

October 30, 2024

1. SSTAC Meeting called to order by Jeannie Morvay-Clayton at 10:02 AM.
2. Introductions and a Determination of a Quorum were made.
3. SSTAC currently has five vacancies.
4. Notice of Meeting and Notice of Vacancies advertised in the local newspaper, letters mailed out to SSTAC interested parties mailing list, notices published on county websites and posted at county buildings.
5. Rachel Nabors moved to accept Draft minutes from April 24, 2024, Erick Hanneman seconded the motion with all members in concurrence.
6. Erick Hanneman gave the group an update on the new transit routing and ride reservation system. Software is onboard and hardware is in the process of procurement. There will be apps for phones and computers for drivers. Transit will still accept call-in requests for rides and provide assistance with scheduling.

Riders will have the capability to load E-passes on their phones and 3B passes. The low income or medical passes are available if a person qualifies for services through HHSA.

The form for new clients through county employees & community partners can help identify people who qualify for 3B passes.

Heritage House no longer has funding for a fixed route in town. Although Transit had discussed adding an in-town fixed route, the one provided by Heritage House was not well used.

Transit has been going to Fresno, Merced and North County daily and is working on a better way to seek medical reimbursements for rides that are covered by insurance plans.

Transit is also looking to add more employees but noted that even with a reduced staff they have been able to accomplish a considerable shortening of the wait time for rides.

Plans are already in motion to increase shopping in Mariposa town area for residence in November and December for additional opportunities for holiday shopping.
