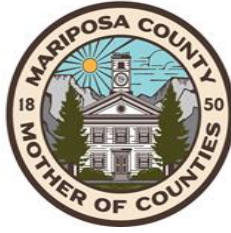

1. SSTAC Meeting called to order by Jeannie Morvay-Clayton at 9:30 AM.
2. Introductions and a Determination of a Quorum were made.
3. SSTAC currently has five vacancies.
4. Notice of Meeting and Notice of Vacancies advertised in the local newspaper, letters mailed out to SSTAC interested parties mailing list, notices published on county websites and posted at county buildings.
5. Rachel Nabors moved to approve Draft Meeting Minutes from October 30, 2024, Erick Hanneman seconded. The motion passed with 4 members voted “Aye” and 1 member abstaining from the vote.

6. Tina McLaughlin moved to approve the Draft Annual Report for 2024, Erick Hanneman seconded. The motion passed with 4 members voted “Aye” and 1 member abstaining from the vote.
7. Erick Hanneman gave the group an update on the new transit routing and ride reservation system. Tracking, fares, and location are all going well. They are getting a lot of information out of the new software which is very helpful. They are still seeing clients calling in and emailing to reserve rides.

They have training planned to help transition the clients over to more smart phone usage of the reservation system. The software can accommodate all three methods.

Outside organizations can request rides directly. Training of outside organizations is being planned.

Tina McLaughlin mentioned trainings, especial at the Senior Center, should be provided in large print with plenty of screen shots demonstrating usage. Mariposa Transit is working on next steps for invoicing directly, bus passes, pre-loaded passes, and a voucher system for methods of payment.

Rachel Nabors reported that the rides to the Mariposa Farmer’s Market were not being well attended and they are discussing dropping that offering and adding trips to the Sonora Farmers’ Market on instead. On Saturdays.

Erick Hanneman is currently working on a schedule to accommodate rides to Mariposa County Fair over Labor Day weekend like they did last year.

8. Jeannie Morvay-Clayton gave an update on the SSB 125 TIRCP/ZETCP funded Zero Emission Transit Yr Project. The consultant reports they are 59% completed on Surveying/Mapping and 61% completed on Field Investigation/Geo Technical Research. They are on track to complete the Environmental Stage toward the end of the year.
9. Jeannie Morvay-Clayton asked if there were any Items of Significance from Council Members on Unmet Transit Needs. There were none at this time.
10. SSTAC Meeting adjourned at 9:48 AM with a motion from Chatherine Chase-Lopez and seconded by Erick Hanneman. Next meeting will be October 2025 date/time TBD.
