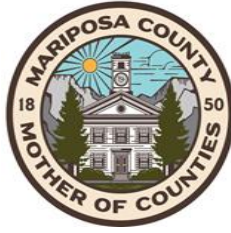

1. SSTAC Meeting called to order by Jeannie Morvay-Clayton at 10:02 AM.
2. Introductions and a Determination of a Quorum were made.
3. SSTAC currently has four vacancies.
4. Notice of Meeting and Notice of Vacancies advertised in the local newspaper, letters mailed out to SSTAC interested parties mailing list, notices published on county websites and posted at county buildings.
5. Rachel Nabors moved to approve Draft Meeting Minutes from April 23, 2025, with correction to Catherine's name, Catherine Chase-Lopez seconded. The motion passed with all 4 members voting "Aye".

6. Rachel Nabors reported that they've seen an increase in ridership, unduplicated riders, and the ability to provide immediate rides is also up.

They are also looking to provide rides for more events like the Veteran's Breakfast, flu clinics, and the Free Admission Day at the Mariposa County Fair.

Focus is going to be software rollout with drivers and more ongoing training.

They are also looking for an opportunity to share information about rides to school when a student has missed their school bus.

Another need within the community is signing up riders who have medical appointments at the different medical facilities for the Online Riders Portal.

7. Jeannie Morvay-Clayton gave an update on the SB 125 TIRCP/ZETCP funded Zero Emission Transit Yard Project. The consultant reports they will have the Engineer's Estimate and 30% Plans to us this week. Next week they will update Engineering on the environmental mitigation requirements for the County. We are on track to exercise our "option to buy" the property in December.
8. Lloyd Clark wanted clarification on the property location for the EV Transit Yard Project and the dates of the events Rachel mentioned in her update.
9. Jeannie Morvay-Clayton asked if there were any Items of Significance from Council Members on Unmet Transit Needs. There were none at this time.
10. SSTAC Meeting adjourned at 10:25 AM. Next meeting will be April 2026 date/time TBD.
